**2018 Hope Festival** - From Tyler of Hope Fest - Thank you so much for your support in making the 2018 Hope Festival a success! Earlier this month on March 3rd, more than 300 volunteers came together to serve 1,066 individuals experiencing poverty/homelessness in King County. Guests were served with necessities like clothes, groceries, and hygiene supplies, as well as services like haircuts, massages and dental care—all for free. Games were open for the kids, 4 translators helped make sure everyone felt welcome, and some guests even walked with a laptop or tablet. Altogether, 484 kids received free toys, 61 haircuts were given, 12 people received free dental care, and 2,400+ pounds of leftover food was donated to local food banks. **BBB BY THE NUMBERS** - Jeri Tolstedt:

- 248 tickets were sold, 46 were given to sponsors and another 10 to vendors and volunteers, for a total of 345 people in attendance
- \$8700 was received from ticket sales
- \$15,000 was received from sponsors
- \$1790 was received from raffle tickets

- \$96 was received from drink tickets
- \$731 was given in cash donations
- \$100 was netted in alcohol sales, after having to pay back \$2120 in alcohol sales
- \$26,477 is estimated in gross income
- \$6,600 in expenses are estimated so far
- \$16,000 ball park estimate in net proceeds!!
